# II. JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform ordered examinations of appropriate anatomical regions in accord with accepted standards of practice and protocol. Understand PET principles. Produce high quality diagnostic images.
- Perform procedures involving ionizing radiation safely and effectively according to federal, state, and institutional policies.
- Maintain records of administered radioactivity, quality control procedures, patient reports, and other required records applying federal, state, and institutional policies.
- Secure radiopharmaceuticals and supplies consistent with manufacturer and institution guidelines.
